The Co-Op's members consist of approximately 60 fishermen who catch groundfish, lobsters, tuna and shrimp.



Our boats have access to some of the most productive fishing areas in the Gulf of Maine. All our boats leave in the morning and return to port each evening with their catch, thus ensuring we have the freshest products available.

Our fishermen take pride in providing the highest quality products. They are equally proud to carry on a New Hampshire commercial fishing tradition that spans nearly 400 years.

The Co-Op's facility is inspected each year by the FDA and has continually met or exceeded all health and safety standards.



Our fishermen understand their responsibility to ensure the availability of fresh seafood for years to come, and thus they comply with the current fishing regulations.

Northern Shrimp

Why choose northern shrimp from the Yankee Fisherman's Co-Op?

- Fishermen have collaborated with researchers to develop gear that virtually eliminates fish bycatch and targets only large shrimp to maintain healthy populations out at sea.
- No mechanical devices are used to sort shrimp in order to reduce the physical damage to fish returned to the sea.
- By purchasing northern shrimp, you are supporting the N.H. commercial fishing industry and a sustainably harvested resource.
- Shrimp carry the N.H. Fresh and Local brand which ensures that they were landed in N.H. and the freshest available product.
- The Co-Op is offering shares for the upcoming northern shrimp season (Jan.-Feb.). Half a share: 5 lbs./week, \$72; Full share: 10 lbs./week, \$128.
